Read all the books for the Reading Challenge. Lanyard and list will be given at the beginning of the year. 4. Participate in a community service project with family, church, or another organization. Present a report to the class of what you did. 5. Take a family field trip during the school year. Write a onepage report and bring a poster with pictures to share with the class. 6. Write a story to share with the class. It needs to be at least four pages, typed, and illustrated (or) create your own ABC book. _____7. Show your teacher how to tie your shoes and zip up/down 8. Memorize addition facts 0-10. The teacher will test this item with a mixed addition timed test.
