- Memorize multiplication facts to 0 -10 and pass the "Math Drills " with a score of 90% accuracy.

- Memorize and recite the Preamble to the Constitution.
- Read and log 3,000 reading minutes before the Soaring Eagle due date. (April).
- Research a topic, write, type, and present a report to the class. (assigned by the teacher)
- Use keyboarding skills to type 15 words per minute.
- Earn a Cursive License by showing mastery of letters and be able to write your name correctly.
- Identify the 7 continents and 5 oceans of the Earth.
- Create a timeline with pictures, dates, and captions, (assigned by the teacher)
- Enter the PTA Reflections contest. This must be completed by the PTA's set due date. (fall)
- Participate in the school musical and / or choir.
- Raise your Acadience reading test score by 200 points.
- Complete an approved Forces & Motion project for the fair. (March)
- Complete and present an inherited traits project as assigned by the teacher.
- During the school year, attend and report on an art exhibit, museum, planetarium, aquarium, musical performance, play or dance performance, Write a short paragraph about the event and present it to the class.
- Observe and record the local weather patterns for 4 weeks.
- During our nutrition unit, record what you eat for one week / or develop a one week meal plan. Choose 1 day of your plan and have your family follow that plan. Turn this into your teacher.
- Be involved in 2 community (non-family) service projects. \*Use the form provided by the teacher for reporting.
- Participate in the 3rd Grades / School-wide "Hot-Reads" program by reading 10 books. Books can be chosen from the 3rd grade list, or the "Hot\_Reads" list. Complete and turn in a book form for each book.
- Student choice learning activity. Must be approved by the teacher by the end of January. .
