12. Label the 7 continents and 5 oceans of the Earth on a map at school.
13. Create a timeline on an assigned subject with dates and illustrations.
14. Show good citizenship by following school and class rules (No excessive "Think Time", Tardiness, or Unexcused Absences)
15. Participate in physical exercise or activity for 30 minutes each week.

16. Enter the PTA Reflections contest. This must be completed by PTA's set due date.
17. Complete an approved Simple Machines project for the Simple Machines' Fair.
18. Attend an art exhibit or museum, planetarium, aquarium, or participate in an extracurricular event such as a musical performance, play, cultural event, dance performance, and then write a paragraph about the event.
19. Observe and record the phases of the moon for one week.
20. Record what you eat for one week. Decide if you have eaten nutritiously then turn in recording sheet to teacher.
21. Be involved in 2 community (non-family) service projects. Use the form provided by the teacher for reporting
