HUSHABYE MOUNTAIN

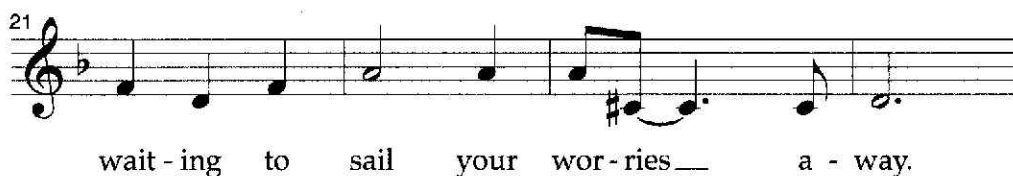
POTTS: What boats?

JEMIMA: The boats in the song Mummy used to sing.

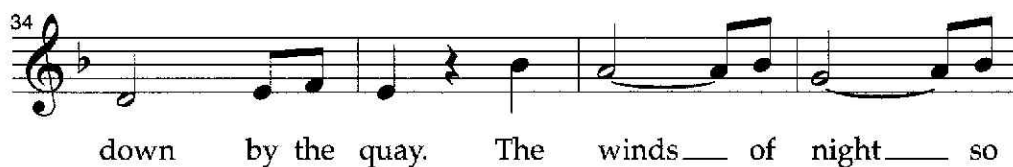
POTTS: Of course.

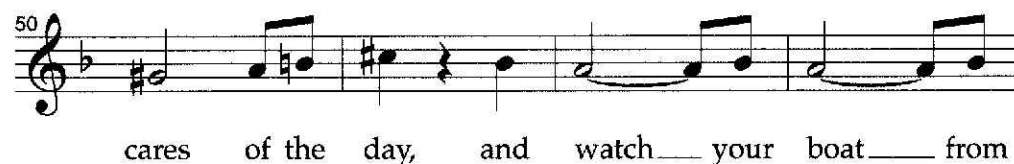
Metronomic Throughout 7 (POTTS:)

creates Hushabye Mountain and the boat.)*

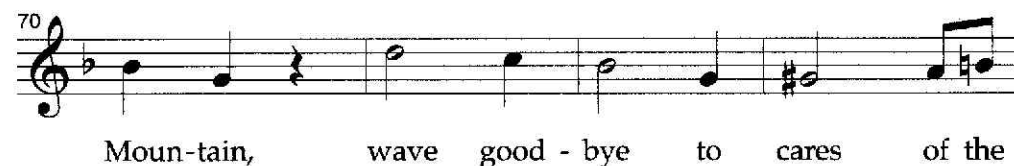


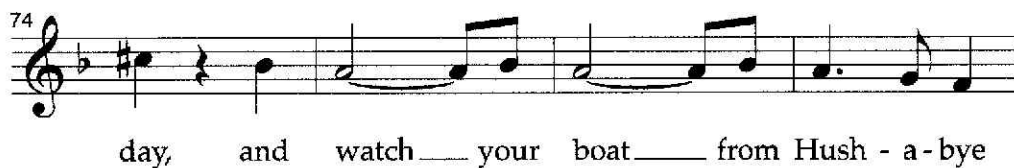


*(JEMIMA and JEREMY are asleep; the

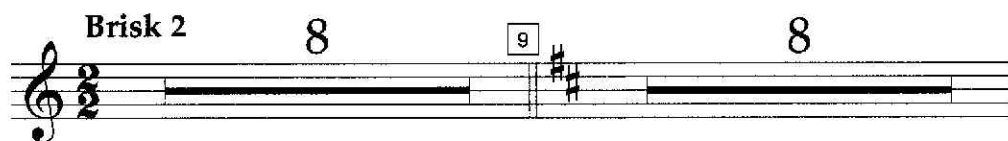


SCENE 6: FUN FAIR
