

# Oakcrest Elementary School

## School Community Council

Location: Oakcrest Elementary Teachers' Lounge

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1. Safety

a. Safety Drop/Pick-up

i. Proposed Changes—The following concerns/changes were discussed regarding streets adjacent to or near Oakcrest Elementary.

1. Hilltop Oak Drive Concerns Southbound—Parents are parking on Southbound Hilltop Oak Drive to pick up their children. At the same time the line of cars waiting to pick up students overflows onto Hilltop Oak Drive.

Additionally, cars driving a through route southward past the school are present. Congestion ensues as the flow of traffic southbound is now three cars wide.

Recommendation: 1. Add a crosswalk and a crossing guard midway through he block north of the parking/drop-off entrance to the school. 2. District safety personnel, West Jordan Traffic Engineer, City Council Member, and West Jordan Police have been contacted about these issues. Discussions are ongoing.

2. Hilltop Oak Drive Concerns Northbound—Parents are parking along Hilltop Oak Drive facing northbound to pick up their students. Parents are crossing Hilltop Oak Drive without a crosswalk and at times are coaxing their children to cross the street. With the aforementioned congestion this creates a safety issue for students and parents. (*See Recommendations above*)

3. 6700 West Concerns—according to the safe walking route, students walk from 8200 South Southward along the East side of 6700 South. Students cross two street that have no crosswalks painted. SCC members are concerned for the safety of students crossing these adjoining streets.

Recommendation: Add this to the 2017-18 Safe Walking Route proposal for West Jordan.

4. 6700 West Crosswalk—a crosswalk which connects to a walkway from the back field of Oakcrest Elementary and dissects 6700 West is an area of concern. At pickup times, parents are parking too close to the crosswalk. Students crossing between the cars are not readily seen by drivers.
